<b>NICOLAS FEUILLETTE RÉSERVE PARTICULIÈRE BRUT, N/V</b> A light golden Rose, a nose of flowers with fruity aromas but also almond and hazelnut. Balanced and elegant Champagne which takes its strong personality from the exceptional crus from which it is composed.	£26.65
<b>PIPER HEIDSIECK BRUT, N/V</b> This is a brilliant non-vintage Champagne with a fine and delicate mousse. Mainly Pinot Noir in the blend, it has an elegant and lively style excellent as an aperitif or with canapés.	£27.75
<b>PIPER HEIDSIECK ROSÉ SAUVAGE, N/V</b> This wine is based on a blend of about 50 different crus with the addition of a proportion of Red Champagne Wine. Matured in deep chalk cellars for at least 30 months before release.	£30.85

<b>VEUVE CLICQUOT BRUT, N/V</b> Bold and masculine with great backbone, mushroomy yeastiness and a delicate mousse.	£29.50

<b>LAURENT PERRIER ROSÉ, N/V</b> Salmon pink in colour the nose is precise and very crisp with lasting impression of freshness hints of red fruits.	£55.25
<b>JACQUESSON CHAMPAGNE CUVÉE N°732, N/V</b> Cuvee 732 is made using grapes primarily from 2004, the remainder made up of older reserve wines. All of the fruit for this wine comes exclusively from grand and premier crus. The final blend comprises of 39% Chardonnay, 36% Pinot Meunier and 25% Pinot Noir. ### St. Estèphe

2003 was a very hot vintage producing ripe grapes, the flavours of this St. Estèphe reflect this. Thick juicy plummy merlot fruit with a lower acidity. Drinking well now.

A great vintage for Bordeaux had resulted in this lovely St. Estèphe. Full bodied with good tannic structure and an aging potential.	
<b>CHÂTEAU PHÉLAN SÉGUR 2002</b>	£27.80
Smooth palate with medium body, ripe tannins and lots of blackcurrant fruits. Hints of spice on the finish.	

### Pauillac

<b>LACOSTE BORIE 2004</b>	£21.30
A classic Pauillac with a rich black currant cedary bouquet followed by medium bodied flavours with richness and tannin.	
<b>CHÂTEAU D'ARMAILHAC 2002</b>	£21.50
An up and coming Pauillac estate. The wine is gorgeously rich with a smoky spice nose and a palate of black plums, currant and leather.	

## St. Julien

<b>CHÂTEAU LA BRIDANE 2000</b>	£22.60
A great vintage this example is filled with rich, curranty fruit with aromas of cedar and spices.	
<b>CHÂTEAU LANGOA BARTON 1997</b>	£28.90
Sweet berry and currant aromas, spicy-cedary medium bodied flavours, low acidity and a pleasant finish. Drink now over the next year.	
<b>CHÂTEAU LAGRANGE 2003</b>	£38.55
Absolutely stunning full bodied and ripe with copious quantities of yummy black cherries and cassis with mineral and charcoal undertones.	

## Margaux

Margaux are the lightest wines of the Medoc but perhaps the most seductive. This wine has a floral, berry bouquet backed up by hints of earth and liquorice.

Medium bodied with good colour and a firm finish.	
<b>CHÂTEAU LABEGORCE 2000</b>	£26.10
Plump medium bodied Margaux with notes of creamy vanilla and lots of cassis. Drink Now – 2012.	
<b>CHÂTEAU MARQUIS DE TERME 2000</b>	£34.00
A full bodied Margaux with firm ripeness and purity. Beautiful smoky oak flavours with notes of violets and lots of black fruit. Divine! Drink now – 2018.	

## Graves

Graves are generally the lightest wines of Bordeaux but they are intensely flavourful and savory.

A lovely Sauvignon Blanc with notes of gooseberries and lemon and a classic Pouilly-Fume, gun flint aroma.

A crisp, dry, fruit driven wine that is a perfect partner to goat's cheese or fish.

One of the best producers of Cairanne, Alary have made a gorgeous wine with cherry fruit and garrigue (a mix of herbs and earth).
- LIRAC, 'DAMEROUSSE', LA MORDORÉE 2005** £11.75  
A gorgeous Lirac offering lovely blackberry fruit with hints of pepper. Juicy and full bodied with a long finish.
- GIGONDAS, DOMAINE DES CARBONNIERES 2003** £13.05  
Powerful wine with dark fruit flavours and farmyard notes.
- VACQUEYRAS, 'BEL AIR', DOMAINE LA BOÛSSIERE 2006** £13.65  
An exciting wine with similar characteristics to Chateauneuf-du-pape.
- CHATEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE, CHANTEROC 2004** £16.45  
The laws of this appellation permit the use of up to 13 grape varieties in the blend. The result is a wine of great complexity. It is full bodied with tannin structure and a long finish.

A gorgeous, aromatic wine with flavours of lychee and rose petals. Heavenly with strong cheese or Asian food.
- RIESLING, STRUBBLER** £7.65  
A dry Riesling with a beautiful aromatic character. Notes of petrol and lime overtones. Delightful.
- PINOT GRIS, GRAND CRU FURSTENTUM, ANDRÉ MERCKLE 2005** £12.40

A noble red wine made from Sangiovese. Full bodied and aromatic with lots of finesse. Good partner for roasts, red meats and feathered game.

Full bodied and aromatic with deep bramble fruit flavours and hints of perfumed rose petals. Lovely with Italian meat dishes.

A complex wine with aromas of currant, blackberry and marzipan. The palate is big rich and warm with a suave texture and an undertone of bitterness or amaro hence the name Amarone

Ripe and juicy with perfumed and peppery tones over forward fruit characters. Densely textured with ripe rich black fruit flavours and spicy aromas.

Outstanding wine, deep ruby red colour that combines notes of fresh black currant, tar, cloves, chocolate and vanilla. The palate is potent but elegant with a good balance and intense persistent finish. 55% Cabernet Franc, 30% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Carmenere.	
<b>SIMON SIG CABERNET SAUVIGNON-SHIRAZ 2005</b> SOUTH AFRICA, STELLENBOSCH	£6.50
Blackcurrant and sweet ripe dark berry flavours of Cabernet integrate seamlessly with exotic cherry spice Shiraz, velvety smooth texture and easy to enjoy.	
<b>SIMON SIG PINO TAGE 2004</b> SOUTH AFRICA, STELLENBOSCH	£8.70
Fresh cherry and brambleberry fruit followed by hints of liquorice. Sweet fruit driven palate.
